Miami-born and internationally acclaimed artist Alexander Mijares was commissioned by The Kiwanis of Little Havana, organizers of Carnaval Miami, to paint the next iconic poster for Carnaval Miami 2017. As is tradition, the artwork is the visual frame for all related activities, including the prominent Calle Ocho Festival and Carnaval on the Mile.

The painting, titled "Café con Musica," is Mijares's tribute to the vibrant Miami culture: from the voraciousness of its streets and the dancing of its people, to the crashing of the ocean waves.

The original piece will be auctioned at "Carnaval Live," a private gala event at Jungle Island on March 10.

EDUCATION



CHANGING THE WORLD ONE CHILD, ONE COMMUNITY AT A TIME

Since 1978, Carnival Miami has been the marquis annual fundraiser of the **Kiwanis Club of Little Havana** in support of the Kiwanis Little Havana Foundation's youth development programs, ranging from initiatives that promote wellness and teamwork to scholarships for graduate education. Host to a series of captivating musical, culinary and recreational events, the iconic Carnival Miami reflects the magic city's unique, vibrant personality and diverse culture shaped by Hispanics of all backgrounds. Since its inception, Carnival Miami has grown into the largest Latin cultural celebration in the world, culminating each year with the world-famous Calle Ocho Festival.

Members of the Kiwanis Club of Little Havana have contributed more than 250,000 volunteer hours to make the following happen:

BASKETBALL LEAGUE: More than 5,000 children have participated in our annual program. Club members serve as coaches and big brothers to the participants.

HEALTHY KIDS: An 8-week summer program, which serves over 250 children from low-income families. More than 5,000 children have benefited from the program, since its inception.

BACK TO SCHOOL: Book bags full of supplies are distributed annually to 6,000 students in low-income elementary schools. Our Back to School program has impacted over 65,000 students since 1991.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM: Deserving Hispanic students are awarded scholarships annually. In 2016, forty students received scholarships to public and state universities. To date, 350 students have achieved their dream of obtaining a college degree.

CHRISTMAS TOY PROJECT: During the holiday season, toys and bicycles are distributed to thousands of children, bringing happiness to more than 8,000 kids each year. Members also participate in our "Adopt a Family" project, which fulfills the needs and wishes of underprivileged families. Our holiday projects have brought smiles to more than 300,000.
